Report Ordinance concerning  
Salary of Engineers -  
15 July 1857.

In the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty one.

An Ordinance ~~to increase~~ <sup>establishing the salaries</sup> ~~for the salary~~ of the Chief and Assistant Engineers of the Fire Department.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:—

- 1<sup>st</sup>— The pay of the Chief Engineer of the Fire Department shall be two hundred dollars annually, commencing on the first day of April last, and this shall be in full of all services.
- 2<sup>d</sup>— The pay of <sup>the</sup> Assistant Engineers of the Fire Department shall be fifty dollars each annually, commencing on the first day of April last, and this shall be in full of all services.
- 3<sup>d</sup>— The above salaries shall be paid quarterly.
- 4<sup>th</sup>— All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
