to which ~~was referred the petition~~ recommended the matter of the proposed extension of Winsor Street, across Main Street, to State Street,

Reports,

Recommending the adoption of the accompanying order for extending and laying out said Winsor Street, in accordance with a plan prepared by the city engineer, dated Dec 6, 1886, and now before this board, - and also awarding damages for land taken and injury to buildings as follows:—

Estate of Moses A. Dow: \$666.62

Heirs of Samuel Woodward: 4,008.11

Total award of damages: \$4674.73

These awards as given in detail in the order, were made after a conference with the Board of Assessors, and upon their advice.

The estimate of the cost of extending and grading the street, as made by the Superintendent of Streets is:
