Chap. 384. AN ACT AUTHORIZING CHARLES M. CURLL TO
TAKE A CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATION FOR

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
defeat its purpose, which is to immediately authorize Charles M.
Curll to take a civil service examination for police officer, there-
fore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for
the immediate preservation of the public convenience. _____

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law or
rule to the contrary regulating the maximum age of applicants
for appointment as a police officer, Charles M. Curll of the city
of Cambridge shall be eligible to take the next open competitive
examination for police officer and, provided he meets all other
requirements, shall be eligible for certification and appointment
as such police officer.
