MAYOR RUSSELL

- WHEREAS: This City Council maintains the safety of all residents and visitors to the City as its highest priority; and
- WHEREAS: Citizens of the Tobin School area have complained of tow trucks, that are under contract to the City, of using the smaller side streets in residential sections for short-cuts while towing cars from Harvard Square and other areas of the City; and
- WHEREAS: These tow trucks are often exceeding the legal speed limit on these smaller side streets which are in neighborhoods in which many children live; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager instruct the Commissioner of Traffic and Parking to require all towing companies that are under contract to the City of Cambridge to use only main thoroughfares, such as Massachusetts Avenue, Concord Avenue, Huron Avenue and Fresh Pond Parkway, that are open to commercial traffic, and to remind these tow companies that the speed limits in the City of Cambridge will be strictly enforced.
