WHEREAS: Members of the Council have received calls from retired City of Cambridge employees (some of whom have been retired for a number of years), who at the time of their employment by the City were assigned to the Cambridge Hospital (or for some the "Cambridge City Hospital") or Neville Manor, concerned about the changes in their health care coverage; and

WHEREAS: The City Manager was the hiring officer (either directly or indirectly) for these employees; and

WHEREAS: These employees at all times during their employment by the "City of Cambridge" received their checks signed by the City Treasurer and contributed to the City retirement system; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager is hereby requested to report back to this City Council relative to retired City of Cambridge employees, who were assigned to the hospital or Neville Manor and who are concerned about changes in their city insurance plans and retirement benefits.
