To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 45, regarding various safety concerns of the North Cambridge Crime Task Force, please be advised of the following:

1. After an inspection by the Public Works Department, it was determined that the overgrown shrubbery is not on the Mobil Gas Station property, but on private property from two adjoining back yards. The Inspectional Services Department will notify the property owners to trim the shrubbery and will follow-up to insure corrective action has been taken.
2. The Public Works Department trimmed the trees at 8 Gladstone Street and 11 Richard Avenue.
3. Commonwealth Electric was notified on 9/18/95 regarding street lights that were out on Fair Oaks Street. City Electrician George Fernandes made a follow-up inspection on 9/26/95 and found all lights working properly.
4. Commonwealth Electric was notified on 9/18/95 regarding a low hanging wire on Foch Street near Alewife Brook Parkway. City Electrician George Fernandes made a follow-up inspection on 9/26/95 and determined the wire had been fixed.
