ORDERED:

That the Order adopted on January 31, 1972 appropriating the sum of fifteen million two hundred thousand dollars (\$15,200,000.00) for sewerage and drainage construction be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

"ORDERED:

That in addition to the amounts previously appropriated the sum of Eleven Million Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$11,400,000.00) be and hereby is appropriated for the construction of sewers and sewerage systems and the sum of Three Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,800,000.00) be and hereby is appropriated for the construction of surface drains, sewers and sewerage systems, all in connection with the following: (1) Construction Program directed towards elimination of existing combined sewerage systems, reducing substantially combined sewage overflows to the Charles River and Alewife Brook; (2) Elimination of cross connections, replacing of missing manhole separation plates, and construction of new sewers or storm drains required to complete separation; and (3) Elimination or reduction of the size of some M. D. C. connections, and it is further

"ORDERED:

That to meet such appropriation of Eleven Million Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$11,400,000.00) the City Treasurer with the approval of the City Manager is hereby authorized to borrow the sum of Eleven Million Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$11,400,000.00) under and pursuant to General Laws, Chapter 44, Section 8 (15), as amended and supplemented, by the issuance at one time or from time to time of bonds or notes of the City, and to meet said appropriation of Three Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,800,000.00), the sum of Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000.00) shall be raised in the current tax levy and the City Treasurer with the approval of the City Manager is hereby authorized to borrow the sum of Three Million Seven Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$3,720,000.00) under and pursuant to General Laws, Chapter 44, Section 7 (1),

as amended and supplemented, by the issuance at one time or from time to time of bonds or notes of the City. Each issue of the bonds or notes authorized by this order shall be payable in not more than thirty (30) years from its date; the City Manager, City Treasurer and City Auditor be and hereby are authorized and instructed to sign and execute said bonds or notes and all transfers and exchanges of the same in the manner directed by the General Laws and the Ordinances of the City of Cambridge; and the City Treasurer be and hereby is directed to bargain and sell and hereby is authorized to transfer and exchange said bonds or notes."

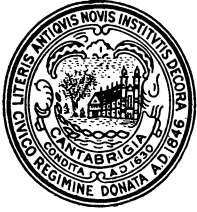

Dear Mr. Corcoran:

The State Emergency Finance Board has requested that the loan authorization approved by the City Council to eliminate pollution in the Charles River and Alewife Brook be divided into two separate borrowings, one for sewers and the other for surface drains, and that a portion of the surface drain authorization be included in the 1972 tax levy.

I enclose herewith an amendment to the loan order adopted by the City Council on January 31, 1972. The amendment accomplishes what the emergency finance board requested and does not change the substance of the borrowing. Since this is an amendment to an ordinance, it should be published and given the requisite readings in the Council.


To the Honorable, the City Council:
