WHEREAS:

James J. Kelley, a former employee of the Fire Department of the City of Cambridge, entered the service of the Fire Department on July 16, 1944 and was pensioned on October 31, 1967 under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 6 of the General Laws and died on March 25, 1977, having served not less than twenty-three years, and

WHEREAS:

At the time of his death said employee had no rights to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor, his widow, Mrs. Mary R. Kelley, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law, therefore be it

ORDERED:

That, under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 101 of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good, and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by James J. Kelley, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Mary R. Kelley, widow of James J. Kelley, of \$1,680.00 per year as long as she does not remarry.



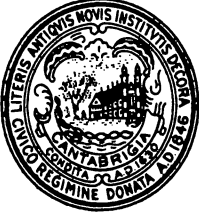
