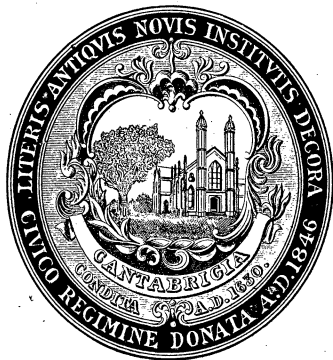

The City Engineer has informed me that he has left in "Sewer Construction-General appropriation, an unexpended balance of only Eighteen Hundred (\$1,800.) dollars. He has before him an order for a sewer in Charles River Parkway for A.D. Little, Inc. authorized by the Council last year on which no work has been done.

He requests an appropriation made as soon as possible by the authorization of a city debt, for the sum of \$10,000.--

I recommend action on the request of the Engineer, and enclose herewith an appropriation and loan order for that purpose.

That the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) be and hereby is appropriated for the construction of sewers for sanitary purposes and for sewage disposal as authorized by Section 5 (1) Chapter 719 of the Acts of 1913.

Ordered

and it is further

That a City Debt be Created

for the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000)
for the purpose of constructing sewers for sanitary purposes and for sewage disposal as authorized by Section 5 (1) Chapter 719 of the Acts of 1913.

and from time to time as the City Treasurer may deem necessary bonds of the City will be issued not exceeding that amount, either in the form of registered or coupon bonds, one or both, to be styled

SEWER CONSTRUCTION LOAN

said bonds to be dated April 1, 1917 and payable \$500 each year from April 1, 1918 to April 1, 1937 both included

with interest at the rate of not exceeding $4\frac{1}{2}$ per centum per annum, payable semi-annually; that the Mayor, City Auditor and City Treasurer be and are hereby authorized and instructed to sign and execute said bonds and all transfers and exchanges of the same in the manner directed by the ordinances of the City, and that the City Treasurer be and is hereby directed to bargain and sell, and is hereby authorized to transfer and exchange the same.
