- WHEREAS: Cambridge Community Television, located studio space at One Kendall Square, constructed the studio and in April, 1988, began to offer services to the Cambridge Community; and
- WHEREAS: Cambridge Community Television offers training in video production, access to studio/portable and editing equipment, and channel time on community access channels 19, 47, 54, 55, and 56; and
- WHEREAS: Cambridge Community Television serves cable television viewers, independent video producers, community organizations, institutions and local businesses; and
- WHEREAS: Cambridge Community Television's slogan is "Television By All Of Us" and the goal is to become Cambridge's own television station with programming produced for Cambridge residents by Cambridge residents; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That I, Alfred E. Vellucci, Mayor of the City of Cambridge, wish to congratulate Cambridge Community Television on its Grand Opening and declare the week of September 29 through October 2, 1988, Cambridge Community Television - Television By All Of Us Week and urge all Cambridge residents to join in recognizing Cambridge Community Television.
