- WHEREAS: Joe's club was affectionately referred to as the Cinderella Team of the state tournament, losing 7-1 to Catholic Memorial in the state final; and
- WHEREAS: Coach McCabe has a 27-10-5 record during his two years at Boston College High School and prior to this position he had been the Head Coach at Don Bosco and served as an Assistant to Marty Pierce at Matignon from 1974 to 1986, a team which received seven state titles; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere congratulations to Boston College High School Hockey Coach Joe McCabe for an outstanding season and for being chosen **"COACH OF THE YEAR"**; and be it further
