WHEREAS: Water is of vital importance in daily life, and Cambridge residents, visitors and the business community depend on high quality, potable water; and

WHEREAS: Significant efforts and many tax dollars have gone into the effort of providing good running water for all residents in Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: In recent months many residents have expressed concern over the quality of Cambridge's public tap water, citing many incidents of yellowish to brown coloration and unusual taste and smell; and

WHEREAS: The number of complaints from residents merit closer examination of the quality of our water sources; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the Cambridge City Council request that the City Manager, through the Water Department, provide a report on the recent rash of discolored water, its causes and what action will be taken to correct the situation immediately.
