

THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS

AN ACT REQUIRING THE MIDDLESEX COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO MEET
TWICE YEARLY IN THE TOWN OF FRAMINGHAM AND IN THE CITIES OF LOWELL AND
CAMBRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court
assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 9 of chapter 34 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended by striking out lines 19 and 20
and inserting in place thereof the following:-

At Cambridge, twice yearly; at Lowell, twice yearly; at Framingham,
twice yearly.
