- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Lieutenant George E. Byars has retired from active duty on the Cambridge Fire Department; and
- WHEREAS: Lieutenant Byars was first appointed a firefighter on June 24, 1951 and upon finishing his military service was assigned to Engine 2 on June 1, 1952 where he remained until February 4, 1959 when he was detailed to the Cambridge Health Department on Special Assignment which also included a detail to the Cambridge Redevelopment Authority from August 1, 1965 to January 10, 1969 at which time Lieutenant Byars returned to active fire duty assigned to Engine 8 and on January 19, 1969 he was assigned to Engine 2; and
- WHEREAS: Firefighter Byars was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant on May 7, 1972 at which time he was assigned to Ladder Company 2 where he remained until September 10, 1978 when he was transferred to Headquarters; and
- WHEREAS: Lieutenant Byars not only exemplified the fire service he also served as a valuable city employee being able to accept and excel in varied municipal assignments throughout his career; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our sincere gratitude to Lieutenant George E. Byars for his dedication to duty and to further extend to him our very best wishes for a healthy and happy retirement; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Lieutenant Byars on behalf of the entire City Council.
