In the year one thousand eight-hundred and sixty-two.

An Ordinance

in addition to an "Ordinance in relation to the Keeping of Swine".

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows: -

Sec. 1. No Swine shall be kept within the limits of the City of Cambridge, without a license first obtained therefor from the Mayor and Aldermen, and then only in such place and named as they shall direct.

Sec. 2. Any and every person who shall keep any swine in any place in the City of Cambridge without first having obtained a license therefor, or in any other place or named than directed by the Mayor and Aldermen, shall forfeit and pay a sum not exceeding twenty dollars, for each and every day during which he shall so keep

the same or any of them.

Secl. 3. Any person who shall offend against any of the provisions of the foregoing sections.

Secl. 3.- The first and second sections of the Ordinance to which this Ordinance is in addition are hereby repealed.

Secl. 4.- This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the first day of June next.
