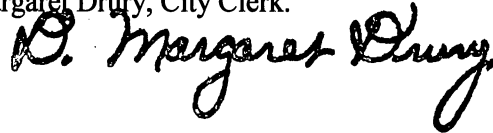

WHEREAS: Berge also received military decorations from the governments of France, Belgium and the Netherlands, including the Croix de Guerre and the Dutch Order of Willum; and

WHEREAS: Berge was a longtime member of the AMVETS, and was its National President in 1973; and

WHEREAS: Berge was a past National President of the All American Conference to Combat Communism and an American Veterans Delegate to the United Nations; and
