To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of \$1,278,613.00 in the Grant Fund from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program to the Human Services Department Salary & Wages Account \$107,453.00 and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account \$1,171,160.00. The funds will be used to assist approximately 4,000 low income clients in the Cambridge and Somerville areas. The maximum benefit level for the upcoming winter is currently set at \$380 per client but is subject to change. Clients must have a household income at or below 125% of the poverty level to be eligible. This appropriation represents the federal contribution to the program, an additional amount of money from the state is expected at a later time.
