- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Lieutenant George W. Fairborn has retired from active duty with the Cambridge Fire Department; and
- WHEREAS: George was first appointed to the department on July 1, 1949 at which time he was assigned to Engine 8 where he remained until February 4, 1951 when he was transferred to the Rescue Company remaining there until January 29, 1956 when he was transferred to Ladder 4; and
- WHEREAS: Firefighter Fairborn was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant on March 27, 1967 and assigned once again to the Rescue Company where he remained until March 5, 1972 when he was transferred to Ladder 2 prior to his last assignment which began on September 10, 1978 to Engine 7 from which he retired on March 23, 1981; and
- WHEREAS: Lieutenant Fairborn will be missed by his colleagues and friends who have grown to know him over nearly thirty-two years of dedicated service which he provided the City of Cambridge; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere appreciation and gratitude to Fire Lieutenant George W. Fairborn upon his retirement and to further extend its wish for a health and happy retirement; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare for presentation a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Lieutenant Fairborn on behalf of the entire City Council.
