The form of ordinance included in the SIP amendment to be submitted to the City Council for approval shall include, inter alia, provisions (i) whereby such ordinance shall become effective sixty (60) days after the final approval of such SIP amendment by the City Council, and (ii) whereby such ordinance shall be substituted for the terms of this chapter on an interim basis assuming that said amendment has not been rejected in writing by the responsible State or Federal agencies as inconsistent with federal or state law.

Upon final approval of such SIP amendment by all governmental authorities with jurisdiction thereof, the City Manager shall notify the City Council of any changes in the SIP amendment as finally approved by such governmental authorities which may require adoption of amendments to the ordinance included in the SIP amendment in order to implement the SIP amendment as finally approved by such governmental authorities.
