WHEREAS: Richard has studied at Boston University, Harvard College, Boston College and Weston College, and written and lectured extensively on the subject of aging; and

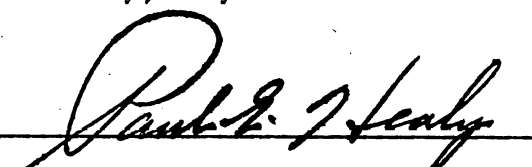
