Report:- That the Committee finds, upon examination, that the abutters upon Erie Street, on March 10th 1850, petitioned that said street might be graded, between Mayazines and Pearl Streets:-

That a Plan of the grade of said street was adopted by the Board of Mayors and Aldermen, Oct. 13, 1850:

That notice was issued, upon the same day, to said abutters to grade said street according to said Plan:-

That on the 20th of October, 1850, the Superintendent of Streets was ordered to grade said street, provided the abutters did not grade the same within one week from said last-mentioned date:

That the Superintendent of Streets reported, Dec. 1, 1850, that he had graded said street, at an expense of \$00.74:-

That said sum, together with the cost of the Plan and expense of assessment, was assessed upon the abutters, Dec. 15, 1850; and a Warrant issued to the City Treasurer to levy and collect said tax:-

That the Treasurer reports that the whole amount of said tax has been paid to him:-

The Committee is therefore of opinion that said street should be laid out and established as a public highway; and the adoption of the accompanying Order is recommended.
