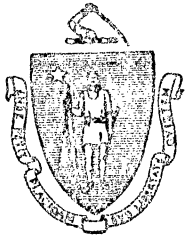

MEMORANDUM - URGENT!

To: Cambridge & Somerville City Officials

Subject: Department of Mental Health Reorganization

The future of the Cambridge-Somerville Mental Health and Retardation Center is in jeopardy. Due to the split of Mental Health and Mental Retardation, the Department of Mental Health is planning a reduction in the number of catchment areas and is combining many areas.

Several plans have been proposed - to combine the Cambridge-Somerville Area with the Harbor Area (E. Boston, Revere, Chelsea, Charlestown, & Beacon Hill) or Tri-City Area (Medford, Malden & Everett). Any combination of areas will seriously dilute our capacity to serve Cambridge-Somerville residents. Please contact our Cambridge-Somerville legislators immediately if you want to preserve area services.

Ask our legislators to call the Commissioner of Mental Health to advocate for the position that the Cambridge-Somerville area should not be combined with any other area.
