- WHEREAS: In October of 1983, The Cambridge City Council went on record establishing a Sister City Relationship with Yatabe, Japan with the purpose of promoting "a joint spirit of friendship and cooperation between two of the leading scientific centers of the world"; and
- WHEREAS: This Sister City agreement was formalized in May of 1984, creating the Cambridge-Yatabe Sister City Committee to organize the cultural and educational exchanges that were called for in the agreement; and
- WHEREAS: The City of Yatabe, under the direction of the federal government of Japan, has recently joined with five other municipalities to form Tsukuba Science City; and
- WHEREAS: The people of Yatabe have indicated a preference to extend the Sister City Relationship with Cambridge to the entire, newly consolidated Tsukuba Science City, Japan, now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council do hereby go on record stating its desire to establish a Sister City Relationship with Tsukuba Science City, Japan; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That this City Council offer its full support and guidance to the Cambridge-Tsukuba Sister City Committee to continue its work of promoting friendship and cooperation between the people of Cambridge and Tsukuba.
