That so much land as may be necessary to make Linnean Street fifty feet wide, in accordance with a plan drawn by Jos. Whitney dated Oct. 1857 and as corrected by a dotted line showing the proposed lines of the street, be taken from the land on the south side of said street, provided the expense of the same to the City does not exceed one hundred dollars above the necessary labor to make the alterations.

The Joint Standing Committee on Roads and Bridges to whom the petition of John Worcester and others dated May 1857 was referred, together with other papers from last years files asking that a survey of Linear street be made and the line of said street be established have considered the same and ask leave to report

The Committee find that a survey was made, and a plan of said street was placed in the hands of John Worcester. In the purpose of effecting a widening of said street, it being understood that the abutters would give the land or pay ~~the~~ ^a portion of the land damages, that no arrangement having been made with the parties interested to give the land necessary to widening said street or pay land damages as yet.

The Committee recommend ~~the~~ widening of Linear street agreeable to the plan drawn by Jas Whitney dated Oct 1857 provided the expense to the City does not exceed One hundred dollars and recommend the adoption of the accompanying Order
