- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Henry Carty Lynch, a Cambridge native and former educator; and
- WHEREAS: Henry, at the time of his death was a Teacher at the Lawrenceville Preparatory School in New Jersey, where he had been a faculty member since 1953, having taught previously at the Brown and Nichols School, Cambridge, and at the Goshen Central High School, Goshen, New York; and
- WHEREAS: Henry attended local public schools, graduating from Cambridge High and Latin School in 1944 and later from Harvard University, where he earned a bachelor and masters degree, and later graduated from the University of Paris; and
- WHEREAS: Henry served with distinction at the Lawrenceville Preparatory School, where he was held in such high esteem by the student body that they dedicated the 1973 yearbook in his honor, and in 1976 he was named to the Sidney Morgan Shea distinguished teaching chair; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mr. Albert Lynch and the entire family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the family on behalf of the entire City Council.
