- WHEREAS: Timothy served as a member of the General Court representing Cambridge from 1928 to 1932, at which time he was appointed to head the IRS Income Tax Division, a position he held until the mid-1950's when he was transferred to the Savings Bond Division of the U.S. Treasury Department, retiring in 1966; and
- WHEREAS: Timothy was an active participant in local civic affairs throughout most of his adult life and was always available to anyone who needed a helping hand; now therefore be it
