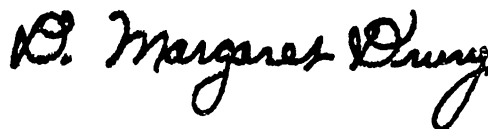

WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge is encouraging the implementation of Transportation Demand Management (TDM) as a means of improving the environment and quality of life by encouraging the use of transportation options (walking, cycling, ridesharing, and public transit); and
