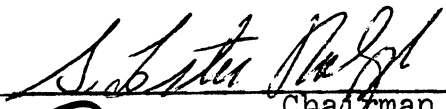
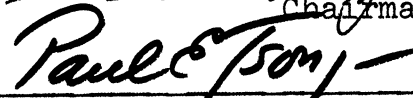
Gentlemen:
