That inasmuch as tenants living in housing projects in Cambridge are living in fear, this City Council declares a "State of Emergency" in all housing development, and be it further

ORDERED:

That the Mayor be and hereby is directed to request the Governor of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to order state police to patrol all housing projects, especially state owned projects, until such time as the Cambridge Housing Authority can supply security police in said projects.

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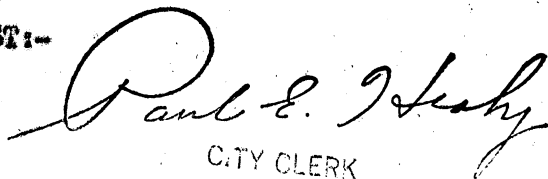
