in relation to Street Numbers.

Be it ordained by the City Council
of the City of Cambridge, as follows:-

The Board of Aldermen may cause
numbers in regular series, of such
form, size, and material, and in
such mode, place, succession, and
order, as it shall from time to time
determine, to be affixed to or inscribed
upon all dwelling houses and other
buildings fronting on any street,
lane, alley, or public court, in the
city -

Any owner or occupant of
any such building or part thereof
refusing or neglecting to so affix to
or inscribe upon the same the num-
ber designated by the Board or
allowing any other number
to remain thereon more than one
week, shall for each offence
