and, that the School Committee take note of the fact that Blue Cross/Blue Shield rates have increased substantially and that the School Department share provides about one-fifth of the City Blue Cross/Blue Shield, and that the School Committee will accept the notion of having the City Manager charge to the School Budget CAP approximately \$350,000.00 of the Blue Cross/Blue Shield charges.

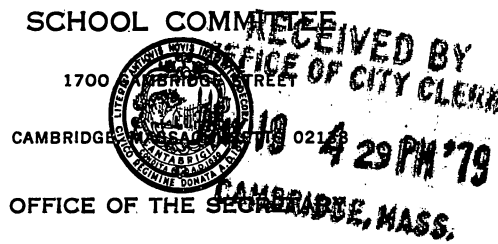

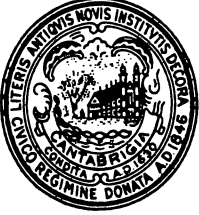


