An Ordinance,

directing the manner in which the ordinances of the city council and the orders of the mayor and aldermen shall be promulgated -

Be it ordained by the city council of the city of Cambridge as follows.

All the ordinances of the city council and all the orders of the mayor and aldermen shall be published and promulgated by causing the same to be inserted four weeks successively in such newspaper as shall be printed and published in the city ~~as~~ or, in case no newspaper shall be printed and published in the city; then, in such newspaper or newspapers printed and published in the city of Boston as the mayor and aldermen shall from time to time designate.
