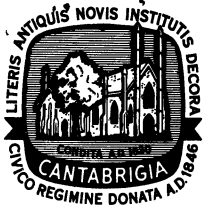

WHEREAS, this City Council is committed to do all within its power to assist and insure the well-being of all the citizens of the City of Cambridge including the residents of the Model Cities area; therefore, be it

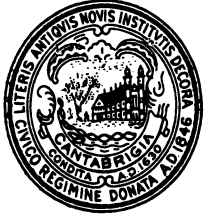
ORDERED that the City Solicitor immediately make a request for a public hearing to be held before the Committee on Ordinances for the purposes of investigating alleged irregularities; conflict of interest, and fraud involving the activities of the Model Cities Agency; and be it further

ORDERED that the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and the Office of the United States Attorney, as well as the District Attorney for Middlesex County be requested to each assign a representative to attend any and all hearings which are scheduled as a result of this ORDER; and be it further

ORDERED that the City Auditor be, and hereby is requested to furnish this Council with an itemized report of all expenditures by the Model Cities Agency for the years it has been in existence; and be it further

ORDERED that the Cambridge Election Commission be and hereby is requested to immediately forward to this Council a detailed and complete report on any and all allegations of fraud arising out of the recent Model Cities election.


