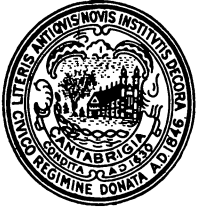

I hereby request an appropriation in the amount of \$133.29 to reimburse Walter J. Holland, an employee of the Public Works Department for damages in this amount.

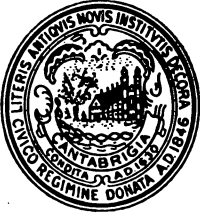
The Law Department under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 41, Section 100-A, defended an action against Walter J. Holland in which there was a judgment of \$133.29.


