ORDERED:

That the following recommendation of the Sub-Committee on Athletics and Physical Education, October 24, 1995, be adopted: that the School Committee go on record as supporting the initiative made by the City relative to Russell Field and to work collaboratively with the City for facilities (preference is Plan 3 as prepared by Brown & Rowe). It is also important that a track facility be linked to the Russell Field plans. The School Committee requests the City to explore all alternatives for a track facility, including Harvard, W. R. Grace, our own grantwriting department, and the S.B.A.B.

Further, that the School Committee ask the City Council to direct the City Manager to initiate a feasibility study for a track and consider the Luisitania Field as well as other locations, and that a track facility for the City and possibly a soccer field within the track be linked to the entire Russell Field project, and that both projects move forward together.

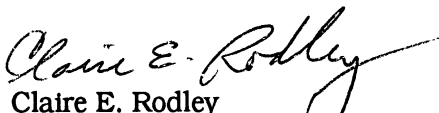
Dear Ms. Drury:
