In Board of Aldermen, Sept. 11, 1867.

Ordered,

Whereas Horse-Blocks, or Stones used for stepping into carriages, are an obstruction to the sidewalks where they stand above its level, and to the street where they project beyond the line of the sidewalk, and may lead to serious accidents,

Ordered, That the Superintendent of Streets be directed to cause all such Blocks or Stones to be lowered or set back, as the case may require, so as to remove all such obstructions and source of danger.
