A RESOLUTION TO PROHIBIT FUNDING OF TRAVEL TO STATES OR LOCALITIES THAT HAVE CONSTITUTIONAL OR CHARTER PROVISIONS THAT PROHIBIT THE ADOPTION OF OR ENFORCEMENT OF LAWS OR ORDINANCES THAT WOULD PROTECT THE CIVIL RIGHTS OF INDIVIDUALS BASED ON THEIR STATUS.

WHEREAS, the State of Colorado has passed a constitutional amendment that prohibits the passage of and enforcement of laws and ordinances that would protect an individual's civil rights based on their sexual orientation; and

WHEREAS, the civil rights laws of the cities of Denver, Aspen and other Colorado cities are affected by this amendment; and
