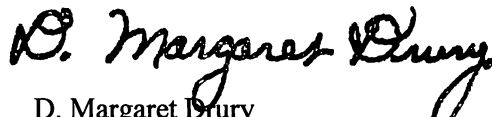
- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened at learning of the death of John F. Cremens on July 26, 2004; and
