

# City of Cambridge

*In Board of Aldermen, December 4, 1900.*

## Ordered:

That the Superintendent of Streets be authorized to construct driveways over sidewalks in front of estates upon the streets as hereinafter named: the expense thereof to be charged to the appropriation for Street Department (Paving: Edgestones and Sidewalks): The entire cost of materials and labor furnished upon such driveways to be repaid by the owners of abutting estates:

- On Linden street, an entrance to be constructed to a passageway for said street to Plympton street. The location is shown by two fences one of which is about 100 feet from Massachusetts avenue, and the second is 115 feet from said avenue. These two fences constitute the lines of the proposed driveway.
- On Newell street, so-called, leading from Huron avenue, an opening to be made and granite circles to be set at the two corners. John B. Fitzpatrick, petitioner.
- On Marcella street, so-called, extending from Portland street to Berkshire street, openings to be made and granite circles to be set at the four corners. Henry Green, petitioner.
