In Board of Aldermen, Sept. 8 1885

Ordered,

That permission be and hereby is granted to Res. John S. Mundy, to lay a pipe for the transmission of steam for heating purposes, under Harvard Street, - from the premises at the southerly corner of Essex and Harvard Streets to the southerly corner of the lot of land on the northeasterly side of said Harvard Street, at the corner of Prospect Street.

Provided, that this permission is granted upon the following conditions viz: a plan of said pipe shall be filed in the office of the City Engineer, and the entire matter of laying the same, shall be under his direction and subject to his approval.

Said pipe shall be taken up and removed at the expense of the owner or owners thereof, whenever in the judgment of this board the public interests shall require such removal. The owner of said pipe to give the city a satisfactory bond in the sum of Three Thousand Dollars, with sufficient securities, to hold the city harmless from any damages that may result therefrom.
