RE: Additional ordinance to animal laws in City of  
Cambridge and change of fine schedule

Addition to Section 21.102. ANIMALS CONSTITUTING A NUISANCE.

Subsection 21.102(a). CONTROL OF DOGS AND CATS IN ESTRUS CYCLE.

If an animal control officer determines that a dog or cat in her estrus cycle, even when confined to the property of the owner or keeper is attracting other dogs or cats to the area, which condition causes disturbances on, or damages to neighboring property or public areas, said officer may impound the dog or cat for the duration of the estrus cycle, releasing it thereafter to the owner or keeper, upon payment of pound fees, or the animal control officer may require the owner or keeper to place and keep such dog or cat, while in such cycle, in a kennel or to remove it from the area so that the nuisance is abated.

Section 21.106. PENALTY. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this Article shall be subject to a fine not exceeding Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars for each offense.
