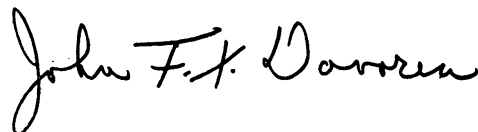

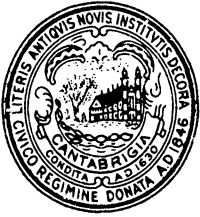

The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

Joseph Hill Associates, Inc. is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes. The charitable purposes are aimed at lessening the burdens of government and promoting the social welfare, through the provision of non-profit consulting services to state and local governments in public policy matters. Such services are provided by graduate students in the appropriate academic areas, who engage in projects determined by negotiations between Joseph Hill Assoc. and specified state or local executive, administrative, and legislative bodies.

The educational purposes include the development and improvement of the capabilities of students by training them in their chosen field of study; such training is by means of actual work experience with government agencies. Students concentrating in public policy areas will derive individual training while state and local governments receive tangible benefits therefrom.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and contributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth above. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision herein, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law). or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law)."

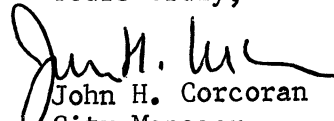
