New permit regulations issued to comply with a Federal District Court ruling, and designed to protect water quality against the discharge of dredged or fill material into navigable waters, were published on 25 July 1975.

The regulation implements Section 404 of Public Law 92-500, the Federal Water Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972. The regulation became effective upon publication; and the Corps of Engineers plans a moderate and reasonable approach in implementing the law through the permit system, to protect the quality of the nation's waters.

PUBLIC NOTICE - PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING - EXPANDED CORPS OF ENGINEERS
PERMITS JURISDICTION

The new permit regulations extend the existing permit procedures, now applicable to traditional navigable waters of the United States, to rivers, lakes, streams and wetlands that are contiguous or adjacent to these waterways. The regulation provides for an orderly expansion of the program in three phases over the next two years.

The purpose of the Public Information Meeting is to explain the permit program as it applies to Section 404 of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972, and to answer questions concerning the program. Interested citizens and groups are encouraged to attend and participate in this meeting.
