Ordered,

That the Superintendent of Streets be authorized and instructed to erect a fence between the City's Gravel Farm and the land of Hittinger, or so much of said fence as it is incumbent upon the City to erect; also to erect a temporary shed at the gravel pit, as a shelter for the City teams while standing at the pit; provided the said shed and fence can be erected at a cost not exceeding Two Hundred Dollars; and that the cost of the same be charged to the Appropriation for Roads and Sidewalks.
