WHEREAS: The Cambridge River Festival is a special time to recognize and celebrate the cultural and ethnic diversity of our city and to showcase more than four hundred and fifty artists in the literary, visual and performing arts; and

WHEREAS: The festival expresses the rich variety of ethnic cultures in Cambridge and provides performances throughout the city to reach people of all ages and backgrounds; and

WHEREAS: The secondary theme within the festival this year is "dance and the movement arts", and acclaimed companies such as the Berkshire Ballet, Prairie Dance Theatre, Impulse Dance Company, and many more will perform during the weekend; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That I, Alice K. Wolf, Mayor of the City of Cambridge, and the Cambridge City Council do hereby recognize the opening of the 1990, 14th annual Cambridge River Festival on Friday, June 8, and do hereby proclaim the weekend of June 8 through 10 to be Cambridge River Festival weekend in Cambridge; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council does hereby congratulate the Cambridge Arts Council for once again producing the Cambridge River Festival; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be instructed to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution for presentation to the Arts Council on June 8, 1990.

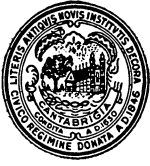
