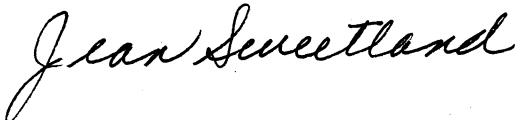
Dear Honorable Mayor Vellucci and City Councillors:
