WHEREAS: The new law authorizes the City o erect flashing lights and post signs establishing safety area designations and special speed limits. Travel in these "Senior Safety Zones" will be restricted to 20 miles per hour; and

WHEREAS: There is concerns amongst seniors in many of our senior housing developments as to the safety in the area. Now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager is hereby requested to confer with the Director of Traffic, Parking and Transportation and the City Solicitor relative to creating "Senior Safety Zones" in the City of Cambridge; and be it further
