In the last few years the City of Cambridge has embarked on a new school building program resulting in the expenditure of several million dollars, and

WHEREAS:

Through this program the City has developed three new elementary schools, and

WHEREAS:

The School Committee is seriously considering building a \$30 million dollar central high school combining both the Rindge Technical and Cambridge High and Latin School, therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That this City Council go on record requesting the City Manager to confer with the Superintendent of Schools, the School Committee, City Treasurer and City Auditor in an effort to determine whether or not this City will have sufficient money to rehabilitate the remaining older elementary schools or to construct new ones where it is deemed necessary, and be it further

RESOLVED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to this City Council prior to the next regular meeting the results of his meeting along with the determinations of the above named department heads regarding this situation.
