- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Reverend Lawrence Duperry, curate at Our Lady of Pity Church in North Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Father Duperry was ordained a Roman Catholic Priest in the Marist Order upon his completion of theology studies at the Marist College in Washington, D.C., and later became a professor of church history, teaching at the Marist College in Framingham, Massachusetts; and
- WHEREAS: Father Duperry, had for most of his religious life ministered to the needs of parishioners in Rhode Island, Maine and Massachusetts and during this time serves as associate pastor at Our Lady of Victories Church in Boston from 1963 to 1980; and
- WHEREAS: Father Duperry will be missed by the many people to whom he has provided spiritual guidance for so many years, people who had grown to truly admire him for his priestly and religious devotion and his ability to inspire others; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the Reverend Irene Duperry, S.M., the brother of Father Lawrence and to the entire family, many of whom are also in the religious life; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Duperry Family on behalf of the entire City Council.
