

City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, April 21st 1869.

Ordered: that the Superintendent of Streets be directed to complete the sidewalk on the Northerly side of Main Street, from West Boston Bridge to its junction with Harvard St in Ward I, and thence on the Northerly side of Harvard Street to Harvard Square, by setting edgestones and laying a brick sidewalk, and also to lay stone crossings across the following streets, on the Northerly side of Main St, viz; Broadway, Court, Pioneer, Dock, Harvard, Washington, School, Harrison, Gilpin, Windsor, Cherry, Austin, Columbia, Douglass, Norfolk, Essex, Prospect, Temple, Furman, the new street through the "Allen estate", Clinton, Lee, Hancock, Dana, Ellen, Newbridge, Remington, Quincy and Harvard; the expense ^{for said edgestones & brick} to be charged to the appropriation for Incidental Expenses and assessed according to law.
